COVID-19 Outbreak at Valley Manor LTC

Public Health declared a COVID-19 outbreak as of October 4, 2024, due to two (2) positive resident COVID-19 cases. Since then we have confirmed two (2) more cases for a total of four (4) positive resident COVID-19 cases. The outbreak is currently limited to Zone 3 (rooms 17-32) and Zone 4 (1-16).

Additional COVID-19 measures will be initiated:

- ✔ Please be diligent in following good hand hygiene practices.
- ✓ Zone 3 & 4 only will be closed to visitors. This may change if further cases develop. Signage has been posted at the entrance to both zones and the doors to the zones will be kept closed during the outbreak.
- ✓ At this time, only Essential Caregivers will be able to visit zone 3 & 4. Those visiting ill residents are to wear an N95 mask (staff will assist in providing a 3M 1870+ mask if not present in the isolation caddy), gown, eye protection (our eye protection is attached to a mask which is worn over the N95) and gloves.
- ✓ No General visitors will be permitted on zone 3 or 4 for the duration of the outbreak unless for essential reasons. Please contact the Nurse in Charge to discuss.
- ✓ Activities will be limited to small groups. Virtual visits by electronic means may be scheduled through the Activities department by calling extension 225.
- ✓ Tray service for all meals will begin for zone 2, 3, & 4 (ALL ZONES as precaution).
